Sept 21, 2020 Board Meeting Highlights

Below is a brief summary of the September 2020 Board of Directors meeting. Visit our website (vwconnected.com) for detailed notes of the meeting.

- Election of Officers: unanimous vote. Results posted on website.
- Pool Building Construction: discussed but not decided.
- Deed Restrictions: discussed but not decided.
- Landscaping contract: discussed but not decided. One contract was favored, and attorney will review.
- Deed Restrictions: various problems discussed but nothing decided.
- Neighborhood sign at Wickersham and Woodland Park lacks water supply: Pros and cons of different methods of solving problem were discussed. No decision made on solution, and further discussion tabled.
- Hayes Road Visibility: Supposed to be clear for 25 feet. Discussed, but not resolved.
- Board and Management monitoring and posting on social media: They should not be expected to answer questions posted on website. Homeowners are to use the Contact Us tab to contact the Board of Directors, and questions and answers will be discussed at the next scheduled Board of Directors meeting.
- Management Company: discussion and vote to amend contract to reduce penalty (from \$18k to \$5K) and change terms of early termination. Changes approved 3-2.
- Crime: Caller worried about increase in crime and drive through traffic on Wickersham. Wants to revisit possibility of installing gates at entry points.
- Risky behavior at pool reported by a caller.
- Caller summarized previous investigation into the possibility of installing gates at entries. She also shared the board's experience with prior management companies and the difficult transitions.
- Caller said he was against removing slide at the pool.
- Caller wanted the crepe myrtles and trees cut down at Wickersham and Olympia.
